January 2009 Minutes – Were read and passed as a true record.

Matters arising –

- Summer tournament to be 16/5/2009
- AFC Norwich proposed merger had been discussed by the Adult men's team and rejected. J Nurse and N Rhatigan had been informed previous to the meeting and AFC Norwich told of our decision.
- $\frac{3}{4}$  pitch now on the common until further notice. The pitch at Orchard Park not to be used until further notice. The goals had been either left up or put up by someone. These are to be taken down and padlocked with padlock from Mulberry Park as original padlock had gone missing.
- Mulberry Park floodlights - K Lewis had been advised by C Yallop of the Parish Council that they had been advised by the Football Foundation that they only need to check the bottom fixings of the floodlight pylons. This they have done. There was still no confirmation about the electrical checking and inspection of the installation on Mulberry Park K Lewis to check with Parish Council
- As J Nurse not at meeting it was not known if Orchard Park electrical installation had been inspected yet.

Car parking on the Common: -

Overall all the parking was OK but there were one or two cars parked on the grass in front of the bungalows. There were one or two complaints. Please note this area does form part of the common and cars should not park on the grassed area in front of the bungalows. J Nurse had sent

an e-mail to the Parish Clerk reminding her of the procedure agreed at the meeting if there were further complaints.

FA Courses: -

- The FA has offered to run three sessions for Mulbarton teams in March on Mulberry Park under floodlights. Dates to be confirmed. These are only to go ahead if the pitch conditions are suitable. These are to be for the Adults Men's Team, The Belles U12`s and U14`s and Junior goal keepers. If they are successful there may be further sessions.
