Minutes from the last meeting: - Were read and passed unanimously as an accurate record of the meeting.

Matters arising: -

- Electrical checking on Orchard Park. J Nurse had been in contact with R Scotter to arrange. Awaiting call from him.
- Summer Tournament. Thanks from J Nurse to all those who had helped in one-way or another. He had a number of e-mails congratulating us on the tournament. So far monies in totalled £995 with expenses for trophies £210. Awaiting money from the Scouts. K Bartholomew to chase up. Problems with Orchard Park barrier had been raised at the Village Hall meeting. Car parking on the change over was a problem for a while. Will need to be looked at for next year.
- Should be staged next year.

Chairman's Report: -

- J Nurse stated that M Lanes team Under 11`s had been awarded the most sporting team in the Norfolk Youth Combination. This is a fantastic achievement for the team, management, players, parents, spectators and the club as a whole and well done to all connected with the team. M Lane introduced Sarah Chapman who would be handling the PR in this respect.
- Managers Discount: - It was proposed by J Nurse that managers and committee members in view of all the work that they do for the club should get a 50% discount off the registration fee for their children. After much discussion it was proposed that this be taken to the AGM to be voted on there. Proposed by J Nurse seconded by M Breslin and carried by 8 votes to 1.

#### Secretary's Report: -

- Insurance for 2009/2010. Youths are £22 per team. Adults £99 per team plus an extra £34 per team for broken bones and weekly benefit excluding the first 14 days of £50 per week for additional £150 per team. It was agreed to keep the same for the next season but each adult manager to reinforce to their players the limits of the clubs insurance and they must make their own arrangements for any additional benefits.
- League AGM's. Anglian Combination. K Lewis and C Carter to attend. SNYL some one needed to attend. Veterans T Fitchew attending. NYCL. N Rhatigan attending. Norfolk woman's and girls League. No date yet.
- Registration forms were given out. Get them filled out and money in asap.

#### Treasurers Report; -

- Balance at 28/5/2009 stood at £11757.75 with an income of £170 and expenditure £316.62.
- The books need to be audited before the AGM. J Minns was approached but unable to help. B Hibbert and J Nurse to approach persons they know to see if they can help. All receipts to be in asap.

- Shape of the event will roughly follow last year`s event. Pitches to be marked out probably six pitches. Start 1:30pm for 2pm. Scouts to be approached by Karen Bartholomew to see if they can do the BBQ
- Managers to organise presentations between the groups.
- Party cannot be at Village Hall as hall booked up this. Should we have one as pre season or not have one this year it was agreed by 7 votes to 2 that we go ahead with the party.
- K Lewis then said he would approach The Worlds End PH to see if they could do something on 20/6/2009. This was agreed.

Annual General Meeting; -

- Input from each manager about how last season has gone. Maximum 2 minutes.
